

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 115
OFFERED BY MR. RICHMOND OF LOUISIANA

Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1 **SEC. 3. STUDY ON EXONERATIONS OF PERSONS CON-**
2 **VICTED OF CAPITAL CRIMES.**

3 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, the Attorney General shall complete a study
5 and submit to Congress a report on persons who were sen-
6 tenced to death by a Federal or State court and who were
7 thereafter exonerated, either before or after the sentenced
8 was carried out. Such report shall include recommenda-
9 tions for preventing wrongful convictions and for miti-
10 gating any inequitable disparities identified in the analysis
11 of such cases, and shall include, for each such person ex-
12 onerated—

- 13 (1) the race or ethnicity of the person;
14 (2) the gender identity of the person;
15 (3) the sexual orientation of the person;
16 (4) the religious affiliation of the person; and
17 (5) a description of the evidence that proved
18 dispositive in exonerating the person.
